M. L. King Elementary staff is committed to the goal of providing quality education for every child in our school. A partnership between families and faculty enriches the educational experience of all children. Students achieve at high levels when families hold an understanding of curriculum, standards, assessments, and district/school policies and procedures. King believes in developing a culture of collaboration between home and school as well as equipping families with the tools to monitor their children's progress.

<u>Parent Participation Plan</u>: M. L. King staff will develop a Parent Participation Plan based on family feedback provided during the Title I meeting and Family Involvement Survey. The plan will be distributed to parents and the local community in newsletters, on the school website, and at other parent events and meeting times. Copies will also be available in the school office. This plan will be revised for the following year at a schoolwide community event in the spring.

<u>Schoolwide Improvement Plan</u>- This year, King will begin to lay the foundation for a Student-Centered Equity Team (SCET). Through an equity lens, based on school data, the SCET will analyze how existing and proposed school policies, programs, practices, allocations, and decision-making processes can unintendedly affect diverse groups of students (racial, ethnic, family economics, mobility, language, family status, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity, disability, or religion) and develop goals and action steps for improvements and/or systems change.

<u>Annual Title I Meeting</u>- An annual event to inform parents of M. L. King's participation as a Title I Schoolwide site, the requirement of Title I, and the rights of the parent to be involved, will occur during Curriculum Night, September 19, 2024 from 4:30-5:00 PM.

<u>Parent-Teacher Conferences</u>- Parents are provided an opportunity to meet with classroom teachers during the district's scheduled conference days, October 18-20, 2023. The Parent/School Compact will be discussed and signed at this time. Families are encouraged to meet with their children's teachers throughout the school year, including our Spring conferences on March 20, 21.

<u>Curriculum, Assessments & Proficiency Levels</u>- All parents will be notified of their child's assessment scores and eligibility for additional academic help during the school day, after school, or in summer programs. Parents are informed of student progress via the Goal Setting Conference in the fall, the Trimester Report Cards, and weekly feedback in the Friday folder. Parents are encouraged to request information regarding their child's academic progress at any time from the school staff.

M. L. King Elementary students are instructed by teachers trained in the use of Reading Wonders. Students requiring additional reading help may participate in programs such as Really Great Reading Suite and Reading Mastery. All students in grades K-5 are instructed using Eureka Math. Students are assessed in a variety of ways including iReady, Smarter Balanced Assessment and curriculum-based measures.

M. L. King staff will participate in a variety of professional development opportunities throughout the school year. Staff will participate in both building and district level professional development focused on improving parent and school partnerships.

Common Core State Standards, the district's Instructional Models, and core curriculum guide the instruction for staff.
